Blue-badge holders	Free parking – please present your car park ticket and Blue Badge to the Security and Car Parking Reception desk in the main entrance
Nominated family members of patients on the Liverpool Care Pathway (the entitlement to free parking can be passed between family members at different visiting times)	Free parking – please present your car park ticket to the Security and Car Parking Reception desk in the main entrance, along with the free parking letter ward staff will be able to give you
Patients who are in receipt of: Pension Credits, Income Support NHS Exemption Certificate, Job Seekers Allowance and Holders of HC2 and HC3 forms	Free parking – please present your car park ticket to the Security and Car Parking Reception desk in the main entrance, along with evidence of your receipt of these benefits
Cancer patients attending for treatment	Free parking – please present your car park ticket to the Security and Car Parking Reception desk in the main entrance, along with the free parking form ward staff will be able to give you
Relatives or carers of a patient accessing cancer services	A concessionary rate of £10.50 per seven day period is available – please obtain a form from the ward and take it to the General Office in the main entrance Mon-Fri 09.00 – 16:50
Patients and visitors/carers of ICU, HDU, SCBU, Dolphin ward and Penguin ward	A concessionary rate of £10.50 per seven day period is available – please obtain a form from the ward and take it to the General Office in the main entrance Mon-Fri 09.00 – 16:50
Parking charges are reduced for outpatient clinics if the Trust is responsible for clinics over running – in such cases, car parking charges will be reduced to £1.50.
